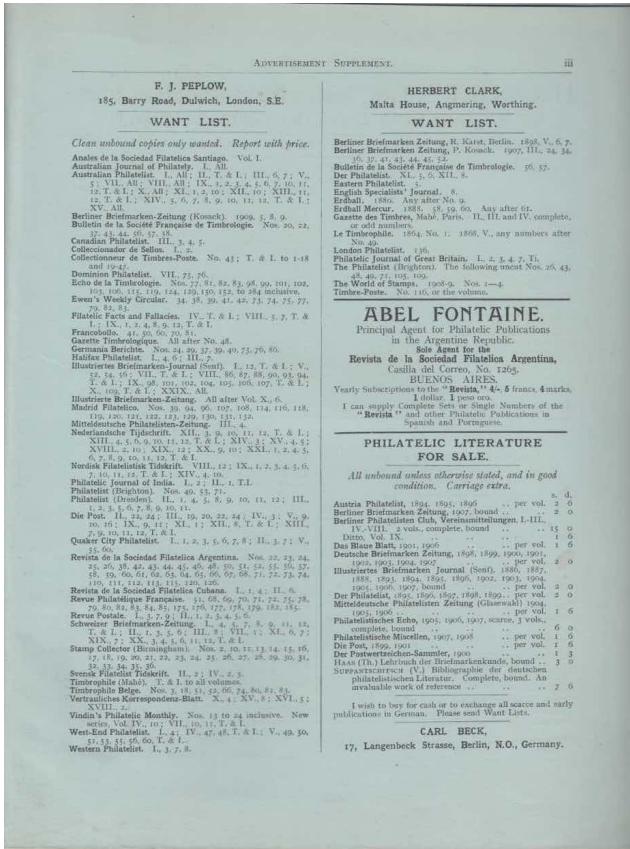

Left: Page iii and Right: Page iv of the Advertisement Supplement to Vol. II No. 4

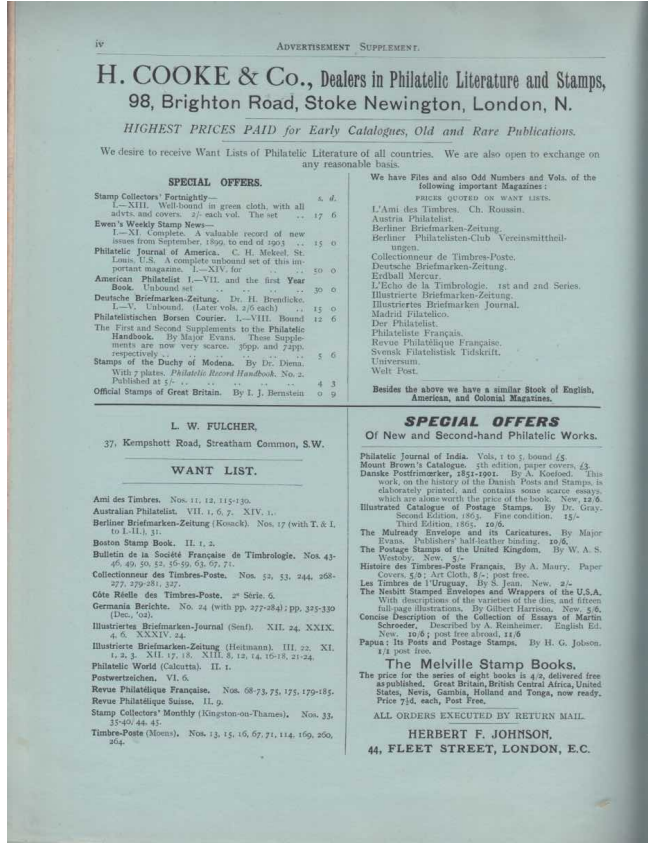

I would also like to clarify that Vol. I No. 2 contain only two printed pages of advertisements and the other two pages are blank and unnumbered. So is the case with Vol. III No. 4. Further, Vol. II No. 1 has six printed pages of advertisements and two blank unnumbered pages. Finally, Vol. I No. 4 contain three printed pages and one blank page. The total number of printed (29) and blank pages (7) number 36.

An updated table of the comments of the supplements is provided below.

Shortly after my article on the Advertisement Supplements to *The Journal of the Philatelic Literature Society* (JPLS) was published in the Q3 issue of this journal ("The Advertisement Supplements to *The Journal of the Philatelic Literature Society*." *Philatelic Literature Review* Vol. 67 No. 3: 194-202), Mr. Rudolf Buschhaus of Duisburg, Germany brought to my attention, for which I am much thankful to him, two additional advertisement pages in Vol. II No. 4 of the JPLS whose description are missing from my table of contents. These pages are available in my run but I missed them while compiling the article. Hence this addendum is required.
